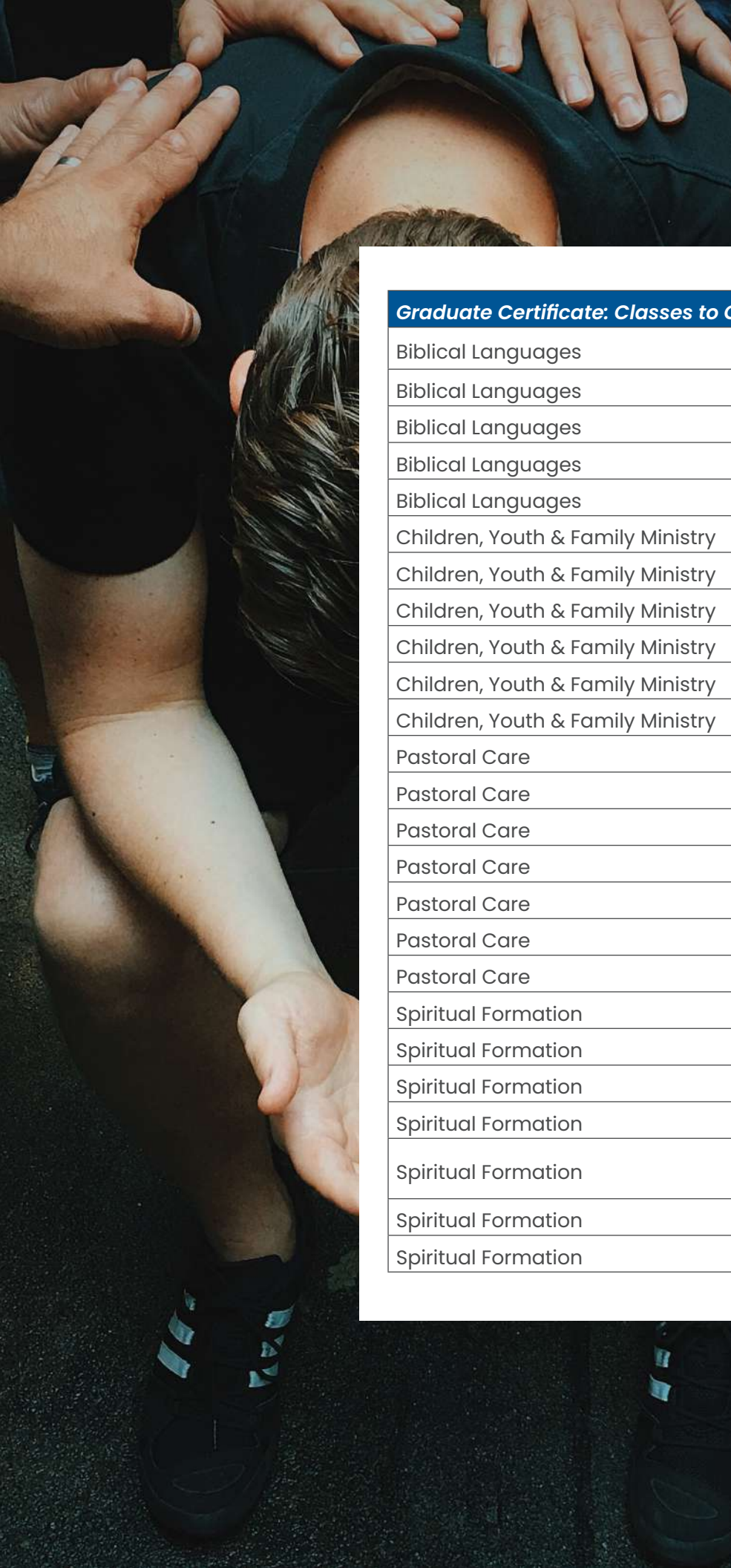
Students may select one of the following areas: General Ministry, Biblical Languages, Children, Youth & Family, Pastoral Care, or Spiritual Formation.
